Please leave the spaces you use clean, so they are ready to be used by other students and programs the day after the event.

Due to the presence of minors at the event, HackCooper has a zero-tolerance policy on alcohol on campus property during the event. Caffeinated products will be provided during the event. Please know your limits and exercise restraint in the consumption of caffeine.
